As you know, Education One, LLC. is the authorizer of Indiana Achievement Academy (IAA), a 9-12 blended model school, located in Indianapolis, Indiana. The initial charter agreement for this school was granted in 2014, with a term of three years.

I am writing to inform you that on June 9, 2015, Education One voted to revoke the charter of Indiana Achievement Academy, effective June 30, 2015. This decision was made due to governance and financial concerns.

In the coming weeks, we will work together with members of the school's Board of Directors and school officials to ensure the proper steps are taken to secure student records and help families and students as they navigate school closure.
