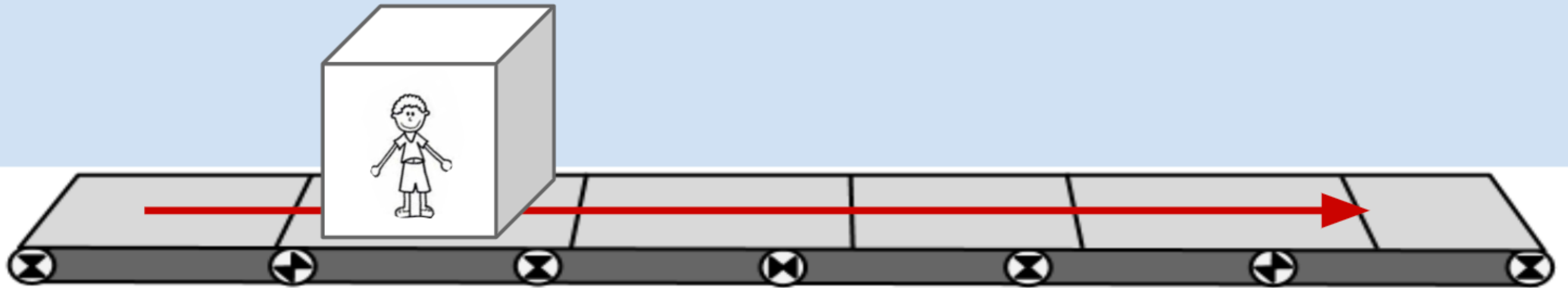

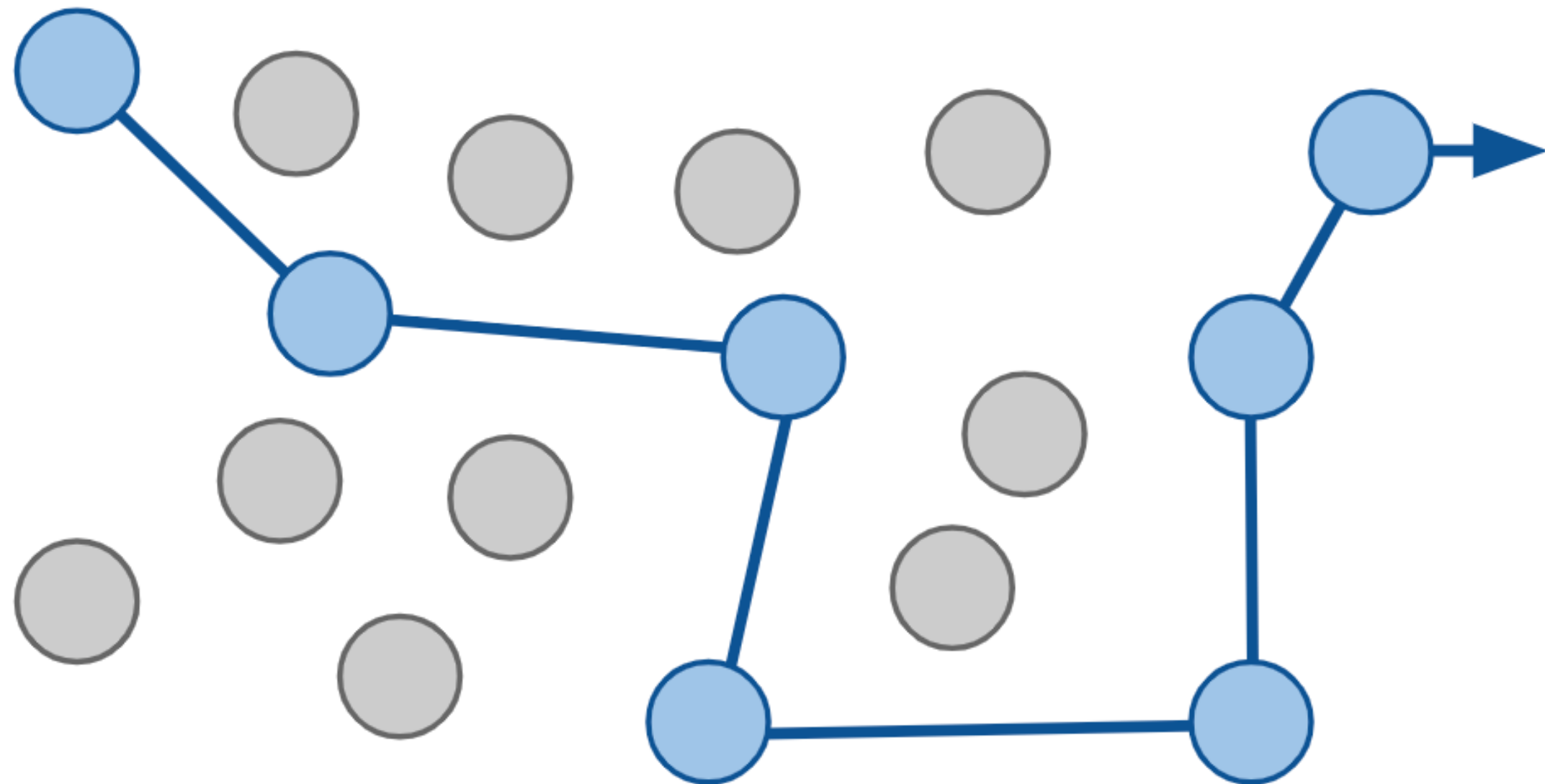

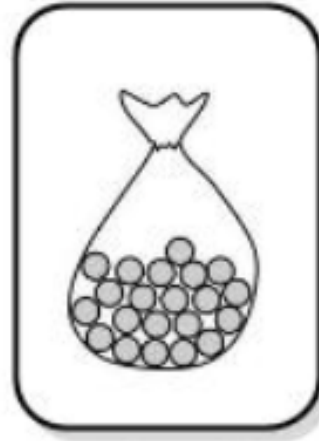
Our fundamental change: move away from a *single path, factory model* of education...

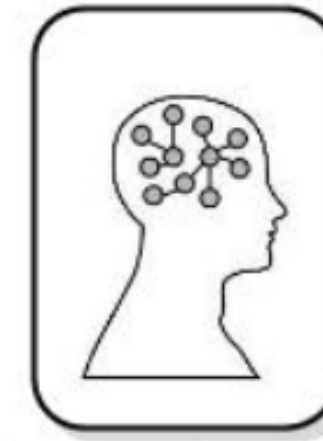

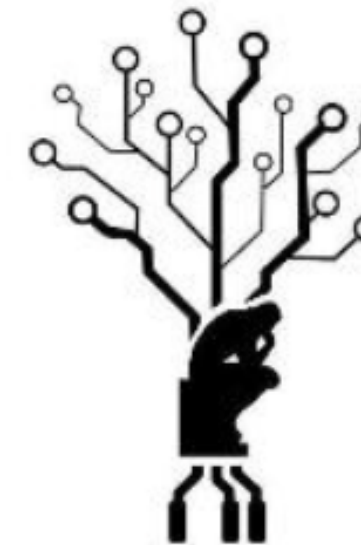
